

## CALCULATING YOUR CATCH HISTORY MULTIPLIER (CHM)

The CHM is based on total groundfish landings in your best four years between 1996 and 2001, relative to other vessels in your size class.

Your size class is based on the vessel size associated with your 2005 groundfish permit (not your maximum upgradeable size).

The multiplier is calculated as follows:

### SIZE CLASS 1 (0 – 29 ft):

CHM	LANDING HISTORY RANGE <i>(best four of six years - groundfish only)</i>
1.0	0 – 19,050 lbs
1.1	19,016 – 33,550 lbs
1.2	33,551 – 62,650 lbs
1.3	62,651 + lbs

### SIZE CLASS 2 (30 – 49 ft):

CHM	LANDING HISTORY RANGE <i>(best four of six years - groundfish only)</i>
1.0	0 – 21,950 lbs
1.1	21,950 – 72,950 lbs
1.2	72,951 – 196,700 lbs
1.3	196,701 + lbs

### SIZE CLASS 3 (50 – 74 ft):

CHM	LANDING HISTORY RANGE <i>(best four of six years - groundfish only)</i>
1.0	0 – 68,100 lbs
1.1	68,101 – 224,400 lbs
1.2	224,401 – 495,200 lbs
1.3	495,201+ lbs

### SIZE CLASS 1 (75 + ft):

CHM	LANDING HISTORY RANGE <i>(best four of six years - groundfish only)</i>
1.0	0 – 138,600 lbs
1.1	138,601 – 516,650 lbs
1.2	516,651 – 1,161,250 lbs
1.3	1,161,251 + lbs
